## LIBERTY CHRISTIAN WELCOMES NEW SUPERINTENDENT



The Board of Directors of Liberty Christian School has announced Mr. Jeremy Cowin as the school's next superintendent. Cowin began his assignment at Liberty Christian School on July 1 and was the commencement speaker at last May's graduation.

"We have clearly sensed God's call of Mr. Cowin to become a part of the Liberty Christian leadership team," said Sena Landey, president of the Board of Directors for Liberty Christian School.

Cowin comes to Liberty Christian School from Village Christian Academy in Fayetteville, NC, where he served as superintendent. Prior to this role, he served as middle school principal of Wake Christian Academy in Raleigh, NC. He also served in teaching assignments for Franklinton Elementary School in Franklinton, N.C., and for Bowling Green Elementary School in Bowling Green, Mo.

Cowin received a bachelor of arts in Elementary Education from Hannibal LaGrange College in Hannibal, Mo. He completed a master of arts in Christian School Administration at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in Wake Forest, NC. He is currently studying for a doctorate in Education from Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in Wake Forest, NC.

Cowin's extensive ministry experience includes serving as a pastor, interim pastor and youth pastor in variety church settings between 1993 and 2001. He and his wife, Heather, have three daughters.

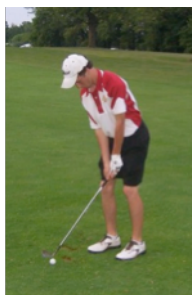

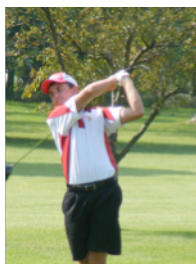
# RECENT GRADUATES START COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC CAREERS

He is the eighth player in Liberty history to score 1,000 points in their career, and only the second to do it while competing in the IHSAA. During his senior year he was among the state leaders in points, assists and rebounds. Following his senior season Horner was invited to play in the 2009 Indiana Class Basketball All-Star Classic at New Castle High School. Michael joins his brother Chris on the Ravens basketball squad.
